Utah is changing their credit card program from an individual liability to a corporate liability program. Tami asked how other states managed their corporate travel card programs and how they address per-diem rates. Several states provided Tami a response including: PA requires itemized receipts, OR follows federal per diem rates and only allows meals on individual liability card. MN has corporate cards and no meals are allowed. CO eliminated their travel card program.

State round table.

PA, Working on resolving the issues with personal bankruptcies and the corporate travel card. They are causing issues with their corporate travel card supplier and human resources. Other bid issue is enforcing their tax exempt status with hotels located within PA.

CO, trying to create a supplemental contract with Avis/Budget. They use the NASPO ValuePoint agreements with Hertz and Enterprise/National. Running into issues with Avis/Budget not wanting to come up to current CO standards.

LA, Working on developing the fine line between compliance and auditing with their travel card program.

OR. Ended statewide agreement with local travel agency. Using the NASPO ValuePoint agreement for travel management services. OR still working through the issues with a price increase request submitted by Enterprise/National.

WV has state codes that indicate they are tax exempt.

MN, getting ready to release an RFP for travel management services. They have concerns about prisoner travel.
